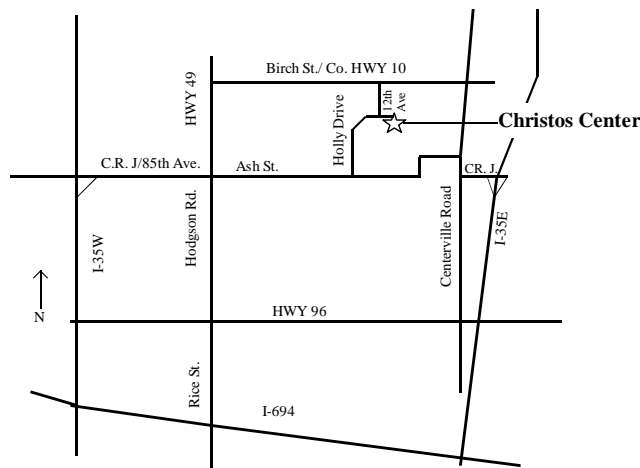

Christos Center for Spiritual Formation was founded in 1978 as Praise of His Glory Ministries. Joann Nesser, a Lutheran lay woman, created the ministry for the purpose of presenting retreats on prayer. The non-profit ministry grew to encompass a wide range of spiritual formation activities such as spiritual direction, formation of congregational leaders, personal spiritual deepening through the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises, and workshops. The current building was built in 1990, and the ministry name was changed to Christos Center in 1992.

Deepening Truth:

The practice of living in the Spirit

A four-session introductory series on contemplative prayer. This class provides an opportunity for intentional listening, exploring prayer practices and a deeper awareness of God's presence in our lives. Each gathering includes an opening prayer experience, a topic-related teaching and small group discussion. Instructor and facilitators are Christos spiritual directors.

This series is held once each year at Christos Center. Others have found it beneficial to "host" this series at their church or facility. The registration fees are reasonable and vary with respective arrangements.



Pilgrimage Local and Abroad

"Walking retreats" to enhance spiritual insight and understanding. Most "pilgrims" seek to encounter God at a deeper level through the people, places and circumstances encountered during their pilgrimage.

Local pilgrimages have been made to St. Anthony Park MN, Northfield MN, the Inner Cities of Mpls/St. Paul, and to Twin City Metro Gardens and other Sacred Spaces.

Christos has also sponsored pilgrimages to Spain and Italy, Ireland and Iona.



Personal Spiritual Deepening through the Ignatian Spiritual Exercises

Ignatius of Loyola helped people on their journey with God through exercises and conversation. The core dynamic of this spiritual formational tradition is prayer, friendship, sharing, and conversation.

Tending the Holy: Preparation for the Ministry of Spiritual Direction

This two year program prepares people for the ministry of spiritual direction or other like ministries. Topics include: history and tradition of spiritual direction, prayer, the spiritual direction relationship, scripture and theology, human development, discernment, and retreat ministry.

Local and distance programs are offered. The local class is held two Thursday evenings a month (7:00-9:30) at Christos Center. People who choose the distance learning option receive their presentations via the Internet and regular communication with Christos Staff. Cost of the program: \$2260 per year payable monthly; \$100 application fee.
